**Registration:** This is a one-design event open to all Laser 4.7 class sailboats. We will focus on beginner sailors. Boats will be entered by completing a registration form and paying the required fees onsite.

**Rules:** The races will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS). The Sailing Instructions will take precedence in case of conflict. This changes RRS 63.7.

**Entry Fee: \$20 and includes skipper lunch and dinner; guest lunches are \$6 each.  
Dinner will be \$10 for guests**

**Scoring:** No predefined number of races is scheduled, a practical number of Races suitable to time limits and weather conditions will be held. Appendix A (low point scoring) will be used, except that a boat's final score shall be the sum of all races with no throw-outs, this changes Rule A2; Starts will be in accordance with Appendix S (three minute start sequence); One race will constitute a regatta.

Based on conditions, "fun" races with modification to rules and mandatory capsizes may be held.

**Classes:** Laser 4.7 Rig (If 5+ Radials wish to register by June 15, a Radial fleet will be added)

**Trophies:** 1st – 5th Overall

**T-Shirts:** Short Sleeve \$13.00. Availability will be limited.
